About MAAP

MAAP provides access to abortion care that ensures no one is denied an abortion because of their inability to pay. We offer financial, practical (covering the costs of travel, lodging, food, and/or childcare), and emotional support to our clients. We trust our clients to know their bodies and needs best. We are a Montana-based nonprofit and affiliate of the National Network of Abortion Funds.

Who we serve

We work with folks facing barriers to accessing abortion care, including both Montanans and folks seeking abortion care in Montana.

2023 by the Numbers

- 93%** MT counties are without an abortion provider
- 211%** Increase in applications for support since 2020
- 24%** Clients are unhoused or housing insecure
- 7x** Out-of-state applications since 2020
- 470** Average distance (miles) traveled by clients
- 33%** Clients already have children

Why MAAP?



Bridging the gap between our fundamental right to access abortion care and our actual ability to access this care.

Abortion is a safe and common medical procedure that allows people to make meaningful decisions about their bodies, lives, and futures. However, many people in Montana and those traveling to Montana face significant challenges in accessing abortion care, such as:

-  **Cost:** Abortion can be expensive, especially for financially vulnerable folks who have inadequate insurance, are experiencing financial abuse in their relationship, or are living paycheck to paycheck. MAAP helps cover the cost of abortion for those who cannot afford it.
-  **Distance:** Montana is a large and rural state, with three abortion clinics (All Families Healthcare, Blue Mountain Clinic, and Planned Parenthood) operating in five cities. Many people travel long distances to reach a clinic, adding to the cost and time of getting an abortion. MAAP helps pay for transportation, lodging, and/or childcare expenses for those who need to travel for abortion care.
-  **Stigma:** Abortion is often stigmatized and politicized in Montana (and beyond), which can make it hard for people to find accurate information, supportive providers, and compassionate communities. MAAP helps connect people with reliable resources, trusted providers, and empowering support before, during, and after their abortion.
